EMBARKING/DISEMBARKING THE HELICOPTER:

It is important that all passengers understand the pre-flight briefing. The instructions given during the briefing, educate you on the procedures to follow during your helicopter experience and are designed to keep you safe at all times. Please follow these instructions for your own safety around helicopters.

PAY ATTENTION TO THE PRE-FLIGHT BRIEFING.

Before you fly, it's important to know what is expected of you. The pilot and/or staff will tell you when and how to enter and exit the helicopter, they are there to ensure your safety but can only do so with your cooperation.

BEWARE OF THE ROTORS- DO NOT APPROACH FROM BEHIND

- Wait for the crews signal before moving toward the aircraft.
- Approach the helicopter from the front or sides only! Never approach the helicopter from the rear and stay in front of the rear doors at all times.
- Stand low in a crouch as you approach a helicopter on level ground that has its rotors turning.





KEEP TRACK OF LIGHT AND LOOSE ITEMS.

- Securing your personal belongings is important.
- Lightweight items can blow away as you near the helicopter.
- Let an item go if it flies out of your hands. You could get hurt if you try to chase it.

EXIT & ENTER WITH SAFETY IN MIND.

- Always depart the helicopter in the same direction you entered it, from the front or side, and make sure it is in the safety zones described above.
- Remember NOT to wave your arms, jump, or lift anything over your head, and keep all loose personal items secure.

Doors, Seat Belts and Headsets Ensure that safety belt is secure before takeoff.

WEATHER

For your safety and the best experience possible, we do not fly in thunderstorms, snow storms, or conditions which produce low-visibility. We want you to have a safe and enjoyable experience when you fly with us, therefore if your flight will be unsafe due to weather or your view of Michigan will be hindered due to low visibility, we will contact you as early as possible to reschedule. If your flight is rescheduled due to weather there is no additional charge.

LIMITATIONS

- 1. Intoxicated passengers will not be allowed to fly.
- 2. Firearms, knives, sharp objects, weapons, compressed gases, explosives & flammable materials are not allowed on the property or inside the helicopter at any time
- 3. Strict 300 lb weight limit per seat and less than 600 lbs for all three passengers.
- 4. Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult and able to sit in their own seat.
- 5. Children under 2 years old can sit on the lap of a parent or guardian.
- 6. All passengers over the age of 16 must have a valid Photo ID.
- 7. It is prohibited to:
 - a. Unbuckle the seat belt during the flight, other than emergency
 - b. Open or close helicopter doors while the helicopter is moving. Other than emergency
- 8. You must arrive at least 10 minutes before your departure time. Failing to do so could result in a change of your reservation.
- 9. No smoking allowed during the flight.
- 10. These limitations are for the safety of the passengers and crew, they are not optional. Pilot in Command has the exclusive right to cancel the flight for any reason they feel can cause an unsafe situation or issue.

IN CONSIDERATION of my anticipated flight(s) the legal sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, I agree, intending to be legally bound hereby, that White Pine Helicopter LLC (Pilot and/or Operator and/or Owner) ("Released Party") SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR MY DEATH OR INJURY TO MY PERSON, OR FOR ANY LOSS FOR DAMAGE TO MY OR OTHERS PROPERTY caused in any manner whatsoever, whether attributable to the Released Party, or for any other reason, occurring during the time that I am in, entering or alighting from an aircraft piloted by or under the control of or owned by the Released Party, and I do hereby waive any right of action against the Released Party from any and all causes or claims that I may have against them from the beginning of time. I further agree not to sue on any such cause or claim. This agreement shall not release liability for Gross Negligence or Willful Misconduct of the Released Party. I agree to indemnify and hold the Released Party harmless for any losses, judgments or damages he or she may incur, including but not limited to attorneys fees, arising out any Law Suit related to the flight and/or enforcement of or legal challenge to this agreement. It is my intention that this agreement be interpreted and enforced to the maximum extent allowed by Michigan law.
